PERSONAL ITEMS:

- ☐ Air mattress, cot, or foam pad (twin-size)
- ☐ Sleeping bag or sheets
- ☐ Blanket and pillow
- ☐ Towels and washcloths
- ☐ Modest swimsuit and shower shoes
- ☐ Toothpaste and toothbrush
- ☐ Soap and shampoo
- ☐ Any prescription medications
- ☐ Laundry/plastic bags (for dirty clothing)
- ☐ Long pants or jeans
- ☐ Modest shorts
- ☐ Work t-shirts
- ☐ Pajamas, socks, and underwear
- ☐ Work boots or sturdy shoes
- ☐ Water bottle (refillable, to be used at your work site)
- ☐ Personal health insurance card or copy
- ☐ Bible

- ☐ Tools from the Tool List
- ☐ Jacket

- ☐ Alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs
- ☐ Expensive clothes or jewelry
- ☐ Anything really valuable
- ☐ Fireworks, weapons, knives, lighters or toy guns
- ☐ Gummy bears
- ☐ Skimpy or revealing clothes
 - ☐ Please bring clothes that are appropriate in any situation. Longer shorts, t-shirts, modest swimsuits, etc.
 - ☐ Guys and girls dress code: modest shorts/pants and full t-shirts.

YOUTH TOOL LIST:

- ☐ Safety goggles
- ☐ Work gloves
- ☐ N-95 disposable dust mask (used when scraping paint) (5 per person)
- ☐ A tool pouch, bag, or **bucket** (bucket is best option for transportation)
- ☐ Hammer (12 oz. or larger)
- ☐ Tape measure (16' or 25')
- ☐ Carpenter's pencil
- ☐ Paintbrushes: a variety of sizes
- ☐ Paint roller handle
- ☐ Paint roller cover(s) (3 per person)
- ☐ Paint tray with liners
- ☐ Paint scraper and/or wire brush
